Hops

Hops vines have become increasingly popular in the floral industry. What used to be grown solely for brewing are now making their way into the floral industry. One of the most experimental industries, wholesale florists are willing to try anything once. Hops vines have made a

successful start in the market and are continually expanding.

Tip: If you want the hop vines to stay fresh a little longer, it helps to cut a few inches off the bottom and stick them in a bucket of water. They will draw water and that will help them last longer

Hops vines are available now and cut as ordered. They come about 16' in length and are packed:

1 x 44" box
2 x 48" box



Novelty Varieties

Over the past few years we have been increasing our selection of oriental varieties in both color and shape. We have begun to focus on adding some novelty varieties to increase our breadth of availability. To support our strong white, pink and yellow varieties, we have introduced Gluhwein, Shocking and Eudoxia.

Gluhwein is a beautiful creamy apricot color. This striking lily has large buds and strong stem. Be sure to get a good look at this beautiful color before it flies out the door!



Shocking is a dramatic two tone red and yellow lily. This beautiful

contrast is very striking to see with large, long lasting blooms.

Eudoxia is a new color available. This creamy orange was a fan favorite in the trial and we now have it available on a regular basis. Be sure to get a look at this new all star lily!

At Oregon Flowers Inc. we have been growing Stargazer lilies for almost 25 years. Lately, it has become more difficult to provide high quality stargazers due to a lack of quality bulbs.

In the US, Stargazers are still a popular lily, but around the world demand is drastically decreasing and therefore bulb-

growers are choosing not to grow Stargazer bulbs.

With this dilemma, we were able to find the Star Fighter lily and it has become a very good substitute over the last several years but these are also beginning to become scarce.

We at Oregon Flowers Inc. have been testing Stargazer type varie-

ties the past few years but it is not easy to find a good replacement for such a well known variety.

To find a variety with the same characteristics and popularity all while growing and selling it at the same price will be a challenge !!
