New Years Eve, "Oudejaarsavond," involves partying with family and friends while enjoying some board games and watching traditional summaries of the

year by popular Dutch comedians on TV. On the stroke of midnight the Dutch dash out to the streets and indulge in a variety of pyrotechnics.

The Meskers' Family wishes you a very happy New Year, and they would like to share their special family Appel beignets recipe, also known as appelflappen. The Meskers will enjoy a delicious 'appelflap' on your behalf to help usher in the New Year the Dutch way!



Appelflappen Recipe:

1 kg Apples peeled and cored and sliced into 1cm thick slices
Sprinkle with lemon juice and sugar
Let stand for 1 1/2 hr.
250 gr flour with 1/2 of a 300 ml beer make a smooth batter
melt 35 gr margarine blend this with batter and 3 egg yolks and rest of the beer.
Fluff 2 egg whites stiff add 35 gr sugar.
Spoon the egg whites/sugar mixture with flour/beer batter.
Take apple slices through batter into the frying pan (360 F degrees) Bake 3 at a time for 3 min (flip over halfway)
Let drain on paper towels eat warm or cold with powder sugar or cinnamon/sugar
