Standing Orders:

We are accepting standing orders for Tulips now and throughout the tulip season. Please contact your sales person if you would like to set up a specific pack. We are able to accommodate specific quantities, colors, bunch sizes, and even at certain times of the year, specific varieties. This is a wonderful way to offer holiday packs directly to your customers.

Hyacinths

Hyacinths are noted for their long lasting blooms and outstanding fragrance. We will start off the Hyacinth season in mid January with Atlantic (blue) Antartica (white) and Anne Marie (Pink). More colors will be available by Valentines Day including yellow, lavender, purple and peach.

What to expect: You may notice that a bunch of hyacinths seems a bit short. Why is this? We have found that if we harvest the hyacinths right before they begin to

bloom, they are damaged less in transport. We want to be sure that you receive the best product possible, and we have found that shipping them at this stage prevents damage to the blooms. By placing them in water after you receive them, they will increase in length as they begin to blossom.

How to Care for Hyacinths: When you open a box of hya-

cinths, you will notice that there are still roots on the end of the stems. By

harvesting hyacinths in this manner, we get optimum performance from them. The flowers will last the longest and look the best if you take them straight from the box and place them in water. It is very important that you **DO NOT** cut the stems. Change the water often and enjoy the beautiful fragrance.
